1.2P. ELIGIBILITY

The 51st Jean de la Fontaine Cross-Country Rally “City of Soissons” counts for:

- The French Cross-Country Rally Championship – Drivers and Co-Drivers
- The 4x4 Rally Trophy – Drivers and Co-Drivers
- The 2-Wheel Drive Challenge – Drivers and Co-Drivers of Group T1B
- The SSV Challenge – Drivers and Co-Drivers

1.3P. CHECKS

Entered crews can check **on the Facebook page: Rallye TT Jean de la Fontaine, ASA 02** the confirmation of their entry as well as the schedule for presentation at Administrative and Technical Checks (reporting time at the Entrance of the Administrative Checks Hall, **which must be strictly observed**).

It is the responsibility of any driver not appearing on this list at the close of entries to contact the Technical Organizer at the telephone number indicated in Article 1P – ORGANIZATION.

3.1.1.9P NUMBER OF ENTRIES

The maximum number of entries is set at: **150 cars**

3.1.1.10P ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are set as follows:

- With optional organizer advertising: **€600 + €10 for geolocation to the Ligue des Hauts-de-France**
- Without optional organizer advertising: **€1,200 + €10 for geolocation to the Ligue des Hauts-de-France**
- The mandatory Challenge Commissaire fee of **€6 per car (LSAHF) will be covered by the Jean de la Fontaine Racing Team and will not be requested from the competitors.**

Entry fees will be fully refunded in the following cases:

- Entry refused
- Roadbooks not collected (withdrawal declared in writing by email or post)
- If the event does not take place

The organizer will retain the entry fees of competitors who, after collecting their roadbook, do not present themselves at the start of the event, as well as those who fail to notify their withdrawal in writing (by email or post) before Administrative Checks.

3.1.1.11P ENTRY FORM

An entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the full entry fee.

Checks for payment of entry fees must be made payable to: **Ecurie Jean de la Fontaine**

Note: Any entry submitted by email will only be definitively accepted if confirmed by post along with payment of the entry fee.

In case of a waiting list, priority will be given to complete entries accompanied by the entry fee. A bank account statement (RIB) must be attached to the entry.

Any dispute concerning the entry (including insufficient funds or rejected payment of entry fees by the bank) will be referred to the FFSA for sanction, in accordance with Article 3.10.1 of the International Sporting Code.

3.3P. STARTING ORDERS

In accordance with the French Cross-Country Rally Championship regulations

3.3.2P. ALLOCATION OF NUMBERS

In accordance with the French Cross-Country Rally Championship regulations

ARTICLE 4P. CARS AND EQUIPMENT

In accordance with the Cross-Country Rally specific regulations and the FFSA and FIA Cross-Country Rally technical regulations

4.3P. SERVICE / SERVICE PARK

In accordance with the Cross-Country Rally specific regulations ;

Service crews must CLEAN THE AREA OF ALL MUD TRACES left after each intervention on the competition cars.

ONLY one service vehicle per competition car will be allowed in the service parks, with a "SERVICE" sticker affixed to the top right of the windshield.

A penalty of €200 will be applied by the Stewards for each infringement observed under Article 4.3.P. Penalties are cumulative. The amount of the penalty will be retained by the organizer.

4.9P. GEOLOCATION

The installation of the geolocation system must be considered a mandatory safety measure, equivalent to a harness or other safety equipment. It is therefore compulsory.

Throughout the duration of the Rally, **all cars must be** equipped with a tracker, which will be provided at Technical Scrutineering before the event against a deposit (by cheque or cash **of €200**).

This deposit will be refunded upon return of the trackers, except in cases where the tracker is not returned within the indicated deadline.

In the event of retirement, trackers must be returned to the Rally HQ, or if not possible, handed over to an event official. If this is not possible, the trackers must be sent by parcel no later than the day after the event to the following address:

The league undertakes to refund the deposit, even in the event of total or partial destruction of the tracker resulting from an **accident** during the rally.

Operating and rental costs are **€10 per car**.

No wiring is required, as these trackers are self-powered for the entire duration of the rally.

Throughout the rally, any competitor found without their tracker in place or having tampered with the protective film will be sanctioned by the Stewards Panel, with penalties potentially including exclusion.

ARTICLE 5P. ADVERTISING

5.1P. VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION

In compliance with the standard rally regulations and the French Cross-Country Rally Championship regulations.

5.2P. ADVERTISING

Mandatory and optional advertising will be specified by an addendum to these Supplementary Regulations.

The mandatory AGORATT advertising must be affixed to the FFSA-designated area on the front plate of the vehicles and must be visible, in accordance with Article 5.2 of the French Cross-Country Rally Championship regulations. Failure to comply will result in the penalties provided for in Article 5.2.4 of the standard rally

regulations: a €160 penalty for the first infringement and a €320 penalty in case of a repeated offence.

ARTICLE 6P. SITES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

6.1P. Description

The 51st Jean De La Fontaine Cross-Country Rally “Ville de Soissons” covers a total distance of 334.73 km, including 196.08 km of liaison sections.

It is divided into 2 legs and 5 sections and includes 10 special stages with a total competitive distance of 138.65 km.

The special stages are as follows:

The special stages are:

- SS 1/3/5: Missy – Celles 12.690 km
- SS 2/4/6: Braine – Chassemy 14.180 km
- SS 7/9: Coincy 14.940 km
- SS 8/10: Fère-en-Tardenois 14.080 km

The time schedule can be found in the “Itinerary” appendix.

6.2P. **RECONNAISSANCE**

In accordance with the French Cross-Country Rally Championship regulations.

Competitors must provide the registration numbers of the reconnaissance motorcycles and quads and must wear the wristbands issued by the organization, as well as affix the stickers on the reconnaissance motorcycles/quads.

Failure to comply will result in the prohibition of reconnaissance participation, with penalties applied as provided in Article 6.2 of the FFSA standard rally regulations.

6.2.6P. **DATES AND TIMES OF RECONNAISSANCE**

Reconnaissance will take place on:

- May 21, 2026, from 08:00 AM to 07:00 PM
- May 22, 2026, from 08:00 AM to 04:00 PM

A reconnaissance logbook, used to record the three permitted passages, will be issued to competitors. It must be presented to the marshals.

Failure to comply with a control check will incur a 1-minute penalty during the first leg.

Reconnaissance must be carried out at reduced speed, as the tracks are open to all traffic. Driving in the opposite direction is strictly prohibited.

A convoy reconnaissance will take place if weather conditions allow.

On May 22, 2026 – Start at 09:00 AM (location) Cultural Centre – Place du Mail, Soissons.

Tyres suitable for the weather conditions are mandatory.

ARTICLE 7 - RALLY PROCEEDINGS

In accordance with the standard rally regulations and the specific Cross-Country Rally rules.

7.2P General Provisions Regarding Controls:

7.2.12P DISTINCTIVE SIGNS

The distinctive signs of the marshals are:

- Road Marshals: vests and badges indicating their role.
- Post Chiefs: vests and badges indicating their role.
- Technical Organizers: vests and badges indicating their role.

7.5.16P

- The calculation of any potential forfait times will be proposed by the Clerk of the Course to the panel of stewards, and may make use of available geolocation data. If this is not possible, the usual methods will be applied.

7.5.17.1P RETIREMENTS

- Any competitor retiring, whether on liaison sections or during a special stage, must report their retirement as soon as possible to the Rally Control, whose phone number is:
 - **+33 (0)3 21 81 47 19**

7.5.17.2P GEOLOCATION ALERTS

The trackers (geolocation devices) are equipped with a “panic” button. This button may only be used to request **urgent medical assistance** and for no other purpose. By activating this button, the competitor acknowledges that the special stage will be stopped and that emergency services will be dispatched immediately.

Failure to comply with this provision may result in a penalty, which can include referral of the competitor to the FFSA Disciplinary Commission by the Clerk of the Course and/or the panel of stewards.

7.5.17.3P RACE ROUTE

Competitors are informed that the apexes of corners and changes of direction, as well as the outer edges of chicanes, will be protected and marked to prevent leaving the race route. Any contact with these markers or crossing them will be considered a breach of the race route.

7.6P PARC FERMÉ (Closed Park / Scrutineering Area)

In accordance with Article 7.6 of the specific Cross-Country Rally regulations, vehicles not equipped with a window net or SSVs are permitted to cover the vehicle with a tarp to protect it from possible adverse weather.

ARTICLE 8P. PROTEST – APPEAL

In accordance with the general FFSA regulations and the FFSA standard rally regulations.

ARTICLE 9P. RESULTS / RANKINGS

In accordance with the French Cross-Country Rally Championship regulations.

ARTICLE 10P. PRIZES

10.1 P : AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremony will take place on Sunday, May 24, 2026, on the Podium at Place du Mail, 02200 SOISSONS, after the last competitor has finished, based on the provisional final classification of the event. Prize cheques will be sent later by bank transfer. (Please provide a bank account number or IBAN with your entry form).

BONUS FOR MEMBERS OF THE JEAN DE LA FONTAINE TEAM

Each crew member (Driver and/or Co-Driver) who is a member of the Jean de la Fontaine Team (Club Card) will receive a bonus of €20 each, provided they appear on the official start list of the 51th Jean de la Fontaine Cross-Country Rally “Ville de Soissons”.

Cash prizes (for a total distributable amount of **€9,865 for 80 starting crews**).

Finishing bonuses will be calculated based on the actual number of starters.

Group and class prizes are awarded if there are at least 5 starters in the group and at least 3 starters in the class.
